



### DUBAI HILLS

The concept for this Dubai Hills project is 'Bottega Veneta Meets The Desert' and the 33,000 square foot residential home showcases quiet, thoughtful design throughout its three storeys. The clean minimalist interiors are somewhat of a design departure for Dubai and show the tides are shifting more towards a raw refinement focusing on authenticity of materials. Dubai Hills fuses contemporary design with the desert landscape and Alix Lawson designed the majority of the furniture and lighting themselves as well as commissioning a vast and expansive art collection from young and emerging artists; from aboriginal works in Australia, to British textile designers and European artisans. There is a sculptural feel to a lot of the design, artworks and furniture that sits perfectly against the minimalist backdrop of the space.
